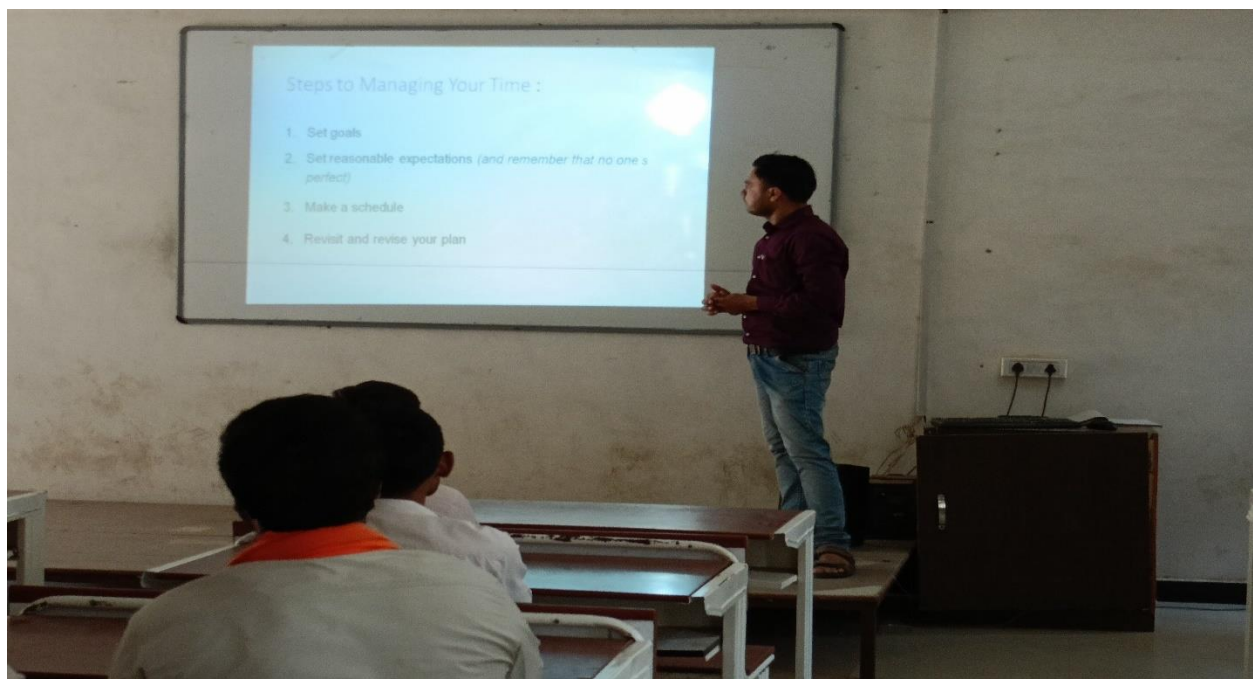
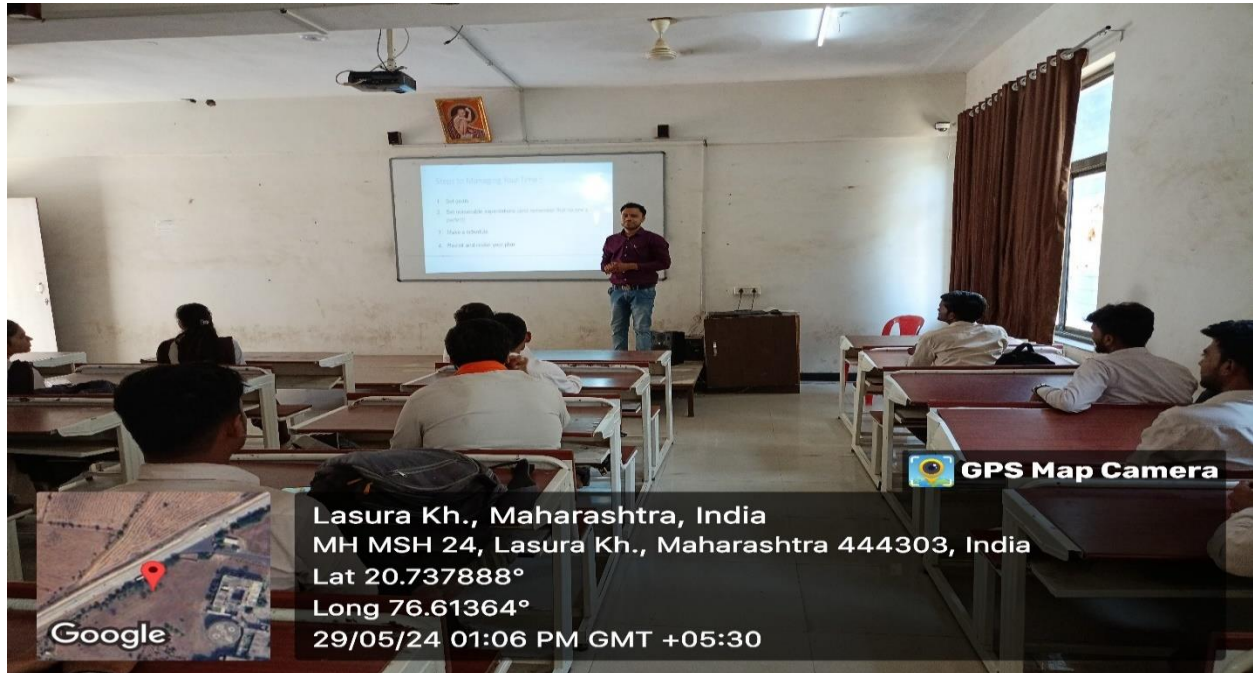




GUEST LECTURE ON COMMUNICATION SKILL
