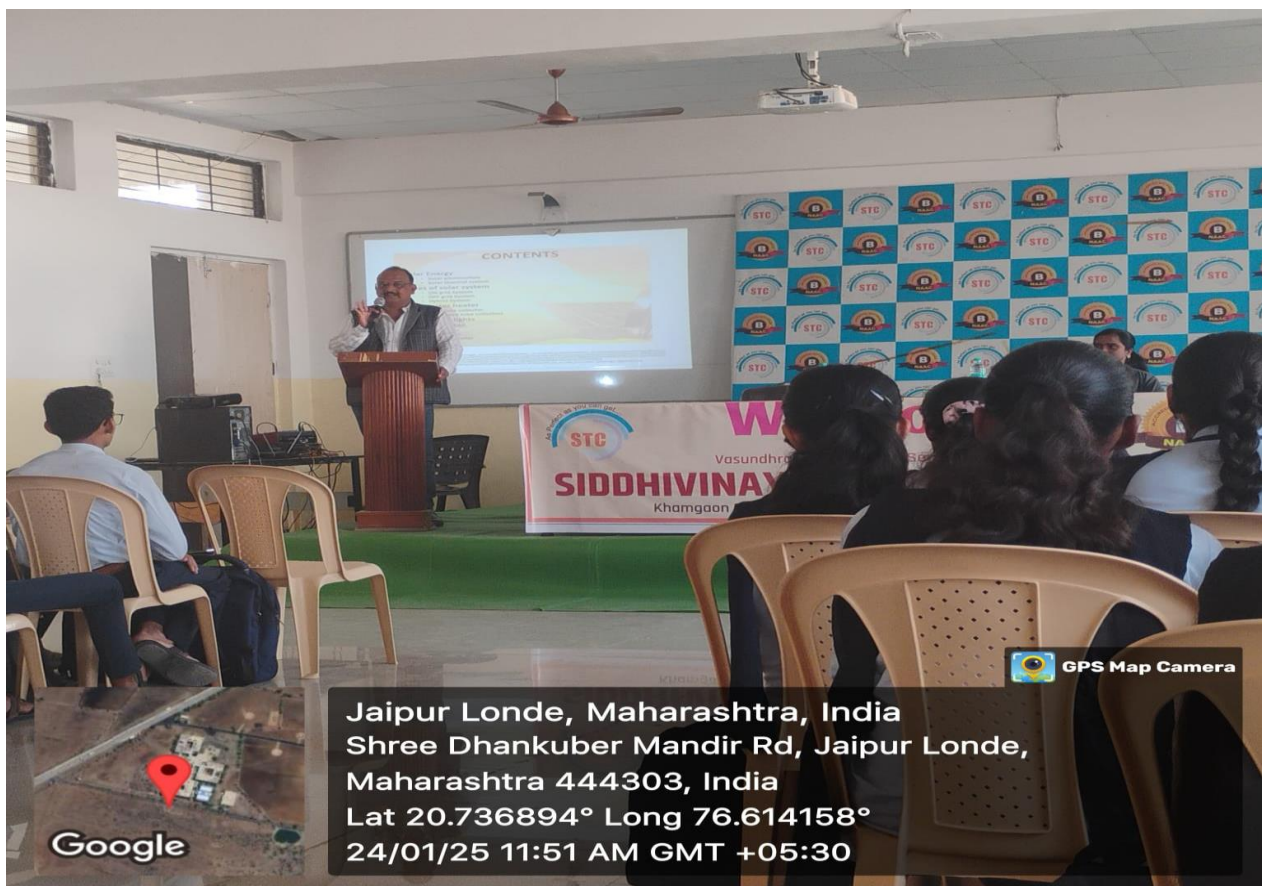


Guest Lectures
